#### **Boys Baseball Updates**

- 7th and 8th grade boys will play Dual County League
  - Competitive League
  - 50/70 Fields
  - Mondays and Thursdays nights of play

- Games will be 2 hours long starting at 6pm
- Games will start mid May and until the end July
- Need to assign a diamond for home games
  - Looking at Eldorado, Brandon North, and Lamartine as options
- Likely need to purchase a portable mound
- $\circ$   $\,$  Not continuous batting order, bat only 9 or 10 at coaches discretion
- Only USA bats allowed. 2 <sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" diameter, Max of -9 drop, max 34" long, no wood or composite wood bats
- LLL teams would be in north division with NFDL, Oakfield, Lomira teams
- Dual league playoffs are proposed for July 15-26. There will be an All-Star game planned for the July 28 weekend
- Fee to play is \$75.00 per each of 2 teams
- All umpires will be 16 and older
- Current Numbers per level:
  - Senior Boys (7th & 8th Grade) 27-28 registered to make 2 teams in Dual County League
  - Major boys (5th and 6th grade) 40 registered to make 4 teams in Ripon League
  - Minor boys 35 registered to make 3 teams
    - Looking to contact teams from Dual County league for additional games at this level since there will only be 3 teams, sounds promising.
    - Option of setting up independent teams to rotate games in at this level.

#### Girls Softball Updates

- Leagues and nights of play
  - 10U will play on Tuesday nights.

- Currently there are 9 teams at this level. Laconia (3) teams,
  Waupun (4) teams and Beaver Dam (2) teams.
- 12U will play on Wednesday nights.
  - Currently there are 6 teams at this level. Laconia (2) teams, Waupun (4) teams and Beaver Dam is stilling trying to form a team at this level.
- 14U will play on Wednesday nights.
  - Currently there is no team at this level, as there were only 4 registrats. Players may join a Waupun Team.
- Current Numbers per level:
  - 10U Girls have 33 registered players.
  - 12U Girls have 28 registered players.
  - 14U Girls have 4 registered players.
- Time limit for games in Waupun is 1 hour.
- First game will start at 5pm with second game starting at 6:30.
- Makeup games will be Mondays at 6:30 or latter.
- Season will start May 28th/29th until July 30th.
