Insurance changes

- Travel Teams (150 additional games). Estimate of \$450.00. Coaches will get a copy and a certificate of insurance.
- Post prom will be on our policy this year. Next year they will purchase their own.
- 2012 Polaris Ranger
 - Needs to be insured \$30 per year.

- Alcohol insurance for sale of alcohol
 - Hosting a Travel league game (10U & 11U boys). This would be a way for the team to make money to cover expenses. Going to try serving at this game. May 18th-20th weekend.
 - Cost of insurance for 1 year is about \$300.00. Insurance would run though the league. Should travel team have to reimburse? Should we consider for the end of the year tournament?
 - Post signs that they can not carry over to the school field. Will have someone there to stop them.
 - Working on purchasing a liquor license.

- Travel team toreimburse the LLL for insurance & license. If alcohol is provided at the year end tournament, the 10U/11U teams will be reimbursed half of the cost of the insurance.
